STUDENT AUTO PARKING PERMIT

All students driving a car or truck to school, need to fill out this form!

Permission Form for Automobile Parking in Student Lot:

Students driving to school must register their automobiles in the office before bringing it to school. At the beginning of the school year, students will be given one week, five school days, to register their vehicle. The form must be signed by the student and the person to whom the vehicle is registered. If a student changes vehicles during the school year, a new form must be completed. If a student may routinely drive different vehicles, each of those vehicles should be registered with the office. If a student drives a different vehicle in a one-time situation, due to emergency or other occurrence, the student does not need to register the vehicle, but must notify office staff of the circumstance. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in loss of parking privileges on school grounds or towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense.

All students driving something other than an automobile, fill out this form!

Permission Form for ATV/UTV/SNOW/OTHER Parking in Student Lot:

Students driving to school must register their automobiles in the office before bringing it to school. At the beginning of the school year, students will be given one week, five school days, to register their vehicle. The form must be signed by the student and the person to whom the vehicle is registered. If a student changes vehicles during the school year, a new form must be completed.
